#### Our Renovation History

- 1951 The church started in a home and then moved to the VFW Hall
- 1954 The original building on what is now the Post Office land was purchased for \$4500
- 1965 A Fireside Chapel was built on our current site and the original building was moved from the PO site
- 1974 The sanctuary was constructed
- 1985 The Fellowship Hall and the Kid's Wing was added
- 1987 A "Burn the Mortgage" capital campaign was completed to become debt free
- 2016 ~\$750K was raised to install an elevator and fire alarm system

Our current facilities have served us well, but we are now at a point where growth and development are essential. The increasing number of community members and our expanding programs require more space and updated amenities to continue our mission effectively. In addition, some parts of our facility simply need repair or updating.

There are ~236 unique givers who support Encounter financially. Therefore, our participation goal is **188 pledges towards Refresh.** 







#### A Note on Tithing vs. Offerings

Tithing and special offerings are two distinct forms of giving outlined in Scripture. Each serve a unique purpose in supporting God's work.



## Tithing

Tithing, as described in the Old Testament, involves giving a tenth of one's resources to God. This practice was established as a regular, ongoing commitment for the Israelites to support the work of the Levites and the maintenance of the tabernacle/temple. In modern times, many Christians view tithing as a consistent way to support their local church and its ongoing ministries. In the New Testament, Jesus commends the Pharisees' practice of tithing, as it aligns with the principles of generous, cheerful, and regularly planned giving taught throughout the Scriptures. Your current level of giving to Encounter likely falls in this category.



#### Special Offerings

In the Old Testament, God commanded the Israelites to bring offerings to build the initial tabernacle and during festival seasons, emphasizing that they "should not appear before Him empty-handed". Today, special offerings provide an opportunity for believers to support extraordinary initiatives or expansions in God's work that may fall outside the scope of regular church budgets. And, they allow givers to demonstrate sacrificial generosity and faith in God's provision. For the Refresh campaign, your giving would be considered this type of special offering.



# The Bible Is Not Silent On Capital Campaigns

In Exodus 35, Moses leads a campaign to build a tabernacle.

Notice the campaign's principles:

- 1. It was a collective effort
- 2. Givers were inspired
- 3. Giving was voluntary
- 4. Contributions had a purpose

"And they came, everyone whose heart was stirred, and everyone whose spirit was willing, and brought the Lord's offering to be used for the tent of meeting, and for all its service, and for the sacred vestments."
